
9. Clean any dirt from around the spark plug bases.

Remove the spark plugs using the spark plug wrench (10) furnished in the tool kit.



- 10. Inspect the electrodes and center porcelain for deposits, erosion or carbon fouling. If the erosion or deposit is heavy, replace the plug.
- 11. Make sure that the 1.0 mm wire-type feeler gauge does not insert between the spark plug gap (11). If the gauge is inserted into the gap, replace the plug with a new one.
