



Your motorcycle is designed and manufactured for off-road use only. The tyres are not made for pavement, and the motorcycle does not have turn signals and other features required for use on public roads. If you need to cross a paved or public road, get off and walk your motorcycle across.

Take Time to Learn and Practice

Developing appropriate off-road riding skills is important to your safety and is a gradual, step-by-step process. You can start by practicing at low speeds in a safe area and slowly build your skills. Getting personal instruction from an experienced rider or a qualified riding instructor can also be very valuable.
