Starting Procedure (except SI)

To restart a warm engine, follow the procedure for "High Air Temperature."

Normal Air Temperature 10° - 35°C (50°-95°F):

- Push the choke lever down all the way to fully ON (A), if the engine is cold.
- 2. Start the engine, leaving the throttle closed.

NOTE:

- Do not open the throttle when starting the engine with the choke ON. This will lean the mixture, resulting in hard starting.
- 3. Immediately after the engine starts, operate the choke lever to keep fast idle at 1,500 2,500 min⁻¹ (rpm).
- 4. About a half minute after the engine starts, pull the choke lever up all the way to fully OFF (B).
- 5. If idling is unstable, open the throttle slightly.
