### SPARK PLUG INSPECTION

A fouled or worn spark plug can cause a host of engine malfunctions.

### Cleaning

- Use a spark plug cleaner to clean the spark plug.
- If such a cleaner is not available, clean with a brittle wire brush or piece of wire.

## Adjustment

 The spark plug gap should be adjusted to 0.6-0.7 mm (0.024-0.028 in). To adjust the plug gap, bend the side electrode carefully.


## Recommended spark plug BPR4HS (NGK) or

W14FPR-L (NIPPONDENSO)


 Do not use spark plug of incorrect size or heat range.

#### CAUTION:

- \* The engine is very hot immediately after stopping.
- \* Install the spark plug by hand until finger tight, then using the spark plug wrench, tighten the spark plug 1/2 to 3/4 turn or until the sealing gasket is compressed.



# HANDLEBAR INSPECTION



- · Check for vertical play.
- · Check for heavy or sluggish movement.
- · Check for binding.
- · See if the motorcycle is pulled to one side or unables to track straight.
- · If there is any abnormality, see your authorized Honda Dealer.
