Starting & Stopping the Engine


Starting Procedure

To restart a warm engine, follow the procedure for "High Air Temperature."

The starter motor will operate only when the transmission is in neutral.

Normal Air Temperature 10° – 35°C (50° – 95°F)

CENTRE OF HANDLEBAR



- (1) choke knob
- (A) fully ON
- (B) half way position
- (C) fully OFF
- 1. Pull the choke knob (1) up all the way to fully ON (A) position, if the engine is cold.
- 2. With the throttle slightly open, press the start button.
- Pressing the electric start button for more than 5 seconds at a time may cause the starter to overheat and damage the starter. Release the starter button for approximately 10 seconds before pressing it again.
